Bio Safety Officer Position Description

Who

- Can fulfill multiple positions (coach/BSO, manager/BSO) but give priority to BSO when required;
- The BSO must be clearly identifiable wearing a High Vis Vest.

Purpose

- Monitor and report Btas Return To Sport Guidelines
- Record names and number of attendees at an event
- Minimise risk of community transmission in a venue
- Provide information to CAM/Club if a positive test occurs

Bio Safety Officer Position Description

Duties

Monitor maximum of four courts

Complete the venue checklist pre event

Take attendance and names of participants

Ensure equipment is sanitised in accordance with Return To Play Guidelines

If required ask people to physically distance or not enter venue (capacity, illness)

Will return and signed checklist and attendance list

Report non compliant persons

Can complete dual roles (coach/BSO, match manager/BSO)

We recommend they are 18 years of over

Pre Event Checklist

Completed before practice or games

Prior to 10 minute entry window

Practical suggestions

- Multiples - pens, clipboards, vests
- Sign off and storage – 21 days
- Snap, send, store

Attendance Taking and Storage

- Prior to entering the stadium
- Ask cold and flu symptoms – entry or deny
- 10 minutes to enter before session starts
- Attendance can be found [here](#)

Practical suggestions

- Multiples - pens, clipboards, vests
- Sign off and storage – 21 days
- Snap, send, store
- Pre populate forms with participant details

Bio Safety Officer Role During Event

- Be nice!
- Entry and exiting protocols
- Maintain physical distancing of 1.5 meters of spectators if attending
- Not allow people to attend the session outside to 10 minute in/out window
- Manage basketball sanitisation if required

Communications to Members

- Information before all events commence
 - Be ready for practice and competitions, changerooms will be available but the philosophy remains of get in and get out
 - If possible hot shower before and certainly after the event
 - Basketball sanitised before and after
 - Do not come to event if not well
